**Starting time:** 9:00am, Saturday June 21, 2008.

**Where:** 7-U Hunting Ranch and Sporting Clays, 3982 Birch Road, Vale, Oregon

**Directions:** From the Boise area take I-84 west to Ontario, Oregon. At Ontario, take exit 374 and follow US 20 West to Vale, Oregon (about 18 miles). In Vale, go straight through town on US 20. At the west edge of town, watch for the sign to Bully Creek Reservoir (the sign is green) and take the right turn indicated (it is actually the right side of a fork) on Graham Blvd. Take Graham Blvd west 1.7 miles and turn Right (north) on Birch Road. Follow Birch Road 1.7 miles to the 7-U Hunting Ranch on the right. If you have GPS enter the address 3982 Birch Road, Vale, Oregon.

**Miscellaneous:** The weather is predicted to be in the mid-80's and sunny so bring your sun block! The area around the pond we will be using for the water retrieve has tall grass and there are mosquitoes – you might want to have long pants and mosquito repellent for that activity. All food for the picnic will be provided by the Club.

**Puppy - (less than 6 months) \$5 entry fee**

Make two (2) 4 to 5 ft shallow water retrieves. Will be judges on enthusiasm, and not much on swimming ability. Retrieves must at least be completed to the water's edge to qualify. Handlers can move backward in order to assist in bird delivery.

**Puppy - (6 – 15 months) \$5 entry fee**

Make one (1) 10-15 ft. retrieve, and one (1) 30ft (10 yards) retrieve . Must be able to swim, and retrieve must be completed to the water's edge (minimum acceptable). Handlers can move backward in order to assist in bird delivery.

**Derby - (15 - 24 months) \$7 entry fee**

Make one (1) 10 yard retrieve, and one (1) 20 yard retrieve. Retrieve must be within three (3) large steps by the handler. Handler can move backwards to assist in bird delivery.

**Gun Dog - (Dogs do not have to be broke) \$10 entry fee**

Make one (1) 20 yard retrieve, followed by a sighted "double" consisting of a short 10 yard retrieve and a longer 20 yard retrieve. Handler can not move forward or backward to complete the retrieve, and retrieves must be within two "large steps" of the handler to qualify. Hard mouth would be penalized.

**Broke Dog \$10 entry fee**

Make one (1) 20 yard single retrieve, followed by a "double" consisting of one 20 yarder followed by a "blind" 30 yarder. Qualifying dogs on this stake must be absolutely steady-to-wing-and-shot, and must absolutely deliver to hand while handler is stationary (no handler movements, forward or backward). Hard mouth would be severely penalized. Hand signals and thrown objects are allowed to guide the dogs on the "blind" retrieve.
