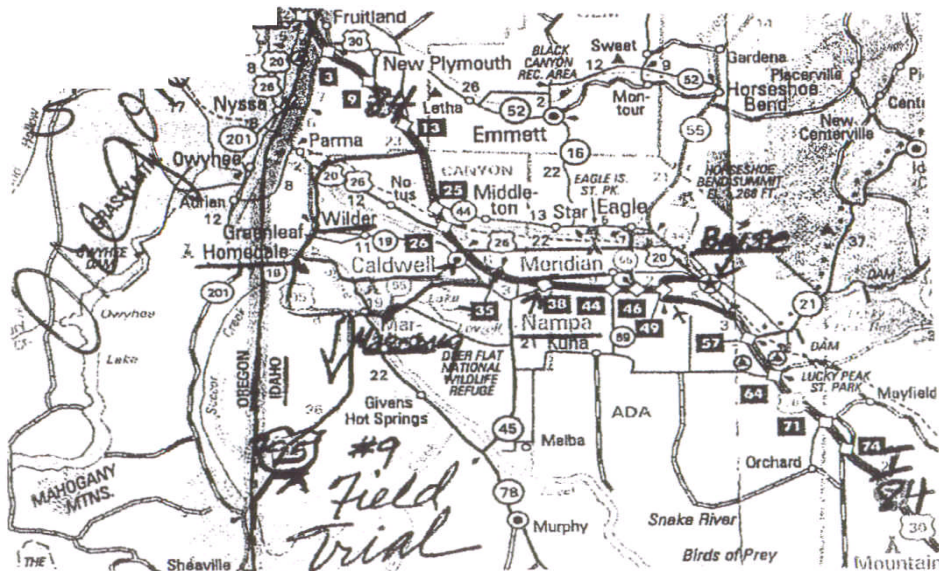

Courses and Birds

Two courses will be utilized. Open Puppy, Open Derby and Open Limited Gun Dog are non-retrieving stakes. Birds will be blanked on course however birds will not be blanked for Open Puppy.

Open All Age, Open Gun Dog and Amateur Gun Dog are retrieving stakes. Birds will be blanked on course, with a Call Back for the retrieve. Chukars, quail, or pigeons planted in all stakes except Puppy.

- Notes: - Shot gun blanks are not permitted.
- AKC approved tracking collars may be used.
